- Conduct TPM (planned maintenance) and maintain all relevant records.
- Conduct the safe installation of new production lines in accordance with engineering and safety standards.
- Conduct in-house relocation of machinery and associated equipment as required.
- Maintain and repair lighting and power distribution systems.
- Maintain and repair compressed air systems and related equipment.
- Maintain and repair lighting and small power systems.
- Maintain and repair equipment on assembly cells, including Siemens PLC-controlled systems.
- Maintain and repair moulding machines and associated equipment.
- Maintain and repair hydraulic and pneumatic plant equipment.
- Conduct pipe work installations and relocations as required.
- Conduct maintenance and repairs to all jigs and fixtures.
- Conduct all necessary oil changes.
- Ensure stock levels of spare parts are maintained and order replacements when required.
- Ensure all plant and machinery comply with Health & Safety requirements.
- Provide cross-departmental support as required.
- Offer guidance and mentoring to Apprentices and Junior Engineers.
- Work towards and achieve personal business objectives (PBO).
- Comply with the Health & Safety Policy and promote a safe working environment for all.
- Provide support during weekends as required to meet operational demands.
- Ensure adherence to the 5S methodology to maintain an organised and efficient work environment.
- Ensure effective communication with colleagues, supervisors, and other departments to support coordination and task completion.
- Complete thorough and accurate handovers at shift changes or job completion to maintain continuity.
- Any other duties as may be reasonably requested by the Facilities and Maintenance Supervisor.
